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

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## Report on Students' Feedback on the Syllabus and its Transaction 2021-2022

In 2021, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Barnagar College in Sorbhog collected feedback on the curriculum of all departments offered by the college. To obtain this feedback, a Google Form was distributed to the students, and 449 respondents participated in the survey.




#### **Overall Rating on the Syllabus**



Based on the feedback received from the students on the syllabus, it can be concluded that the overall rating of the syllabus is good. A total of 448 responses were received, out of which 117 students rated the syllabus as excellent, 280 students rated it as good, 41 students rated it as satisfactory and 10 students rated it as poor.

The majority of the students have rated the syllabus as good, indicating that they are satisfied with the course content and its relevance to their academic needs. However, there is still scope for improvement as a significant number of students have rated the syllabus as satisfactory or poor.

#### Course content of the Syllabus





#### Relevance of the syllabus to the course






#### Size of the Syllabus

#### Electives offered in the syllabus

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



It would be useful for the faculty to take note of the specific books that have received poor ratings and evaluate if they need to be replaced or supplemented with additional materials. Additionally, seeking student feedback on book selections in the future may help ensure that the prescribed books remain relevant and useful to the students.








#### Time frame of the syllabus








### Implementation of career oriented curriculum

### Implementation of career oriented curriculum







1. Overall Rating on the syllabus







#### 2. Course content of the syllabus



#### 3. Relevance of the syllabus to the course






#### 4. Size of the syllabus








#### **Analysis of Employer Feedback:**

2. The employee acquired a sound idea about the current trends and practices in the respective disciplines from the curriculum s/he undertook.




# 3. Syllabus effectively enabled the employee in developing skill oriented human resources


#### 4. The curriculum facilitated an overall holistic development of the employee?

#### 6. How do you rate the communication skill of our students(s) working with you?





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#### **Introduction:**



#### 1. Programme syllabus was well structured







#### 2. Syllabus was updated enough









3. The syllabus prepare you for your career or further education?







4. How effective is the syllabus in developing analytical and problem-solving skills?







#### 6. Syllabus helped to attain new skill



However, there were a few respondents who had neutral or negative feedback on certain aspects of the syllabus, such as its scope in enhancing entrepreneurship skills or its ability to prepare students for research-oriented careers.

Overall, the feedback obtained from the alumni suggests that the syllabus is well-designed and effective in providing students with the knowledge and skills required for their chosen career paths. However, there is always room for improvement and the feedback provided by the alumni can be used to make necessary modifications and updates to the syllabus.


#### 1. Are you satisfied with the student discipline of the college?

#### 2. Does your Child / Institute regularly inform you about the student's performance?




in the library's resources and study material, ensuring a more enriching and supportive learning environment for students.






dissatisfaction. Addressing their concerns and providing necessary support to faculty members can lead to continuous improvement and ensure an even more enriching learning experience for the students.


